



## **ACA Athletic Mitigation Plan for Fall Sports 2021**

With the opening of athletics for the 2021-22 school year Arrowhead Christian Academy has developed the following plan for the safe playing of sports.

This plan has been developed with the guidance of the CDC, AZDH, CAA, AIA, NFHS, and the ACA Campus Health Plan. The following procedures have been developed and coordinated to establish a consistent mitigation plan and its impact on athletic competition.

The athletic coordinator for ACA also serves as the health and safety coordinator for the athletic program.

### Prevention Steps:

- Athletes and coaches exhibiting symptoms will be isolated and not permitted to participate in practice or games.
- There will be no sharing of water bottles, equipment or wearable equipment. Athletes are to provide their own water bottles at practices and games.

### Field Guidelines:

- ACA uses a city of Phoenix field in a public park for home soccer games. At this time, the City of Phoenix has not implemented restrictions on outdoor activities.
- These guidelines are subject to change throughout the season.

### Spectators:

- There are no restrictions at this time.

ACA's compliance with these guidelines is essential to our continued use of the field throughout the season. Non-compliance of the guidelines can result in our permit for use to be suspended.
